### THE YEAR IN REVIEW:

**2024** was another wonderful year for Horse and Buddy. All of our programs thrived, from Therapeutic Riding to Silver Saddles to our new Mental Health programs. We spent much of our year focused on essential maintenance items to ensure our 15 year old facility remains safe and welcomina:

- U Replacing aging gutters to prevent water damage, protect our foundation, and eliminate waterfalls that can spook our horses.
- Repairing our arena fan to keep our horses and participants comfortable in
- U Adding new sand and rubber to our arena for the safety of our horses and participants.
- U Repairing the sensory trail bridge, a key feature of this enjoyable and therapeutic trail.
- Upgrading our arena's electrical system to install LED lights that are safer, brighter, easier to replace, and more energy efficient.
- U Building "The Pines," a dedicated area that serves participants in our equine assisted psychotherapy and equine partnered play therapy programs.

These updates, while not the most glamorous, are critical to maintaining the environment where little miracles occur daily. These improvements will help ensure Horse and Buddy continues to serve our community for vears to come.



We also made an exciting addition to our equipment — a mini hauler! This fits perfectly into the bed of our pickup truck, providing a much more comfortable ride for Finn, our miniature horse and beloved Goodwill Ambassador, compared to our larger horse trailer.

Additionally, two of our instructors shared their expertise at the PATH Region 3 Conference in Virginia, strengthening our connection to the broader equine-assisted services community. Their expertise and collaboration with other centers were greatly appreciated by all in attendance.
